10 **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

11  
12 **Compensation of Aldermen/Alderwomen**

13  
14 **FOR** the purpose of specifying compensation and allowances to be paid to the  
15 Aldermen/Alderwomen for the term of office commencing on the first Monday in  
16 December, 2009.

17  
18 **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

19  
20 In accordance with the provisions of Article II, Section 4, of the Annapolis City Charter, a  
21 commission was appointed by the City Council (R-54-08) to review the compensation  
22 and allowances to be paid to the Mayor and Aldermen/Alderwomen during the terms of  
23 office commencing on the first Monday in December 2009. Pursuant to the  
24 requirements of the City Charter, the Commission submitted to the City Council a  
25 resolution embodying the Commission’s recommendations for compensation and  
26 allowances to be paid to the Mayor and Aldermen/Alderwomen. The recommendations  
27 of the Commission were as follows:

29 *For each year of the four-year term which begins on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009, the*  
30 *recommended compensation and allowances are, as follows:*

31  
32 *Aldermen/Alderwomen: a salary of \$18,500; an allowance of \$1,500 for*  
33 *education and training; and reimbursement of up to \$1,000 in expenses*  
34 *necessary to carry out professional duties.*

2 Prior to final adoption of this ordinance, a public hearing will have been held by the City  
3 Council as required by the Charter.  
4

5 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**  
6 **CITY COUNCIL** that the recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission  
7 for compensation and allowances to be paid to the Aldermen/Alderwomen for the terms  
8 of office commencing on the first Monday in December, 2009, shall be an annual salary  
9 of ~~\$18,500~~ \$12,600, an annual allowance of \$1,500 for education and training, ~~and~~  
10 ~~reimbursement of up to \$1,000 in expenses necessary to carry out professional duties.~~  
11

12 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE**  
13 **ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date of its  
14 passage.
