10 **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

11 **Compensation of Mayor**

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13 **FOR** the purpose of specifying compensation and allowances to be paid to the Mayor
14 for the term of office commencing on the first Monday in December, 2009.

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16 **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

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18 In accordance with the provisions of Article II, Section 4, of the Annapolis City Charter, a
19 commission was appointed by the City Council (R-54-08) to review the compensation
20 and allowances to be paid to the Mayor and Aldermen/Alderwomen during the terms of
21 office commencing on the first Monday in December 2009. Pursuant to the
22 requirements of the City Charter, the Commission submitted to the City Council a
23 resolution embodying the Commission’s recommendations for compensation and
24 allowances to be paid to the Mayor and Aldermen/Alderwomen. The recommendations
25 of the Commission were as follows:

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27 *For each year of the four-year term which begins on December 7th, 2009, the*
28 *recommended compensation and allowances are, as follows:*

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30 *Mayor: a salary of \$120,000 and entitlement to the benefits accorded the city’s*
31 *permanent full-time employees.*
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33 Prior to final adoption of this ordinance, a public hearing will have been held by the City
34 Council as required by the Charter.

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36 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
37 **CITY COUNCIL** that the recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission

1 for compensation and allowances to be paid to the Mayor for the term of office
2 commencing on the first Monday in December, 2009, shall be an annual salary of
3 ~~\$120,000~~ \$78,000, and effective July 1, 2010, increase to \$88,000, and effective July 1,
4 2011, increase to \$98,000, and entitlement to the benefits accorded the City's
5 permanent full-time employees.
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7 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE**
8 **ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date of its
9 passage.
