19 within a 365-day period; and

21 **WHEREAS**, O-06-09 repeals Sec. 17.20.010 from Code of the City of Annapolis.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL**
24 that the FY 2009 Fines Schedule is hereby amended as follows:
