11 **A RESOLUTION concerning**

13 **First Sundays 2009**

14
15 **FOR** the purpose of allowing the sale of arts-related merchandise in the Historic District at
16 the First Sunday events to be held each month from May through October 2009, on
17 West Street ~~and West Washington Street~~; and, waiving certain fees associated with
18 City services in conjunction with these events.

19
20 **WHEREAS,** the West Street Merchants Association seeks the City’s approval through
21 the Special Event Application for Private Use of Public Space (SEAPUPS)
22 to hold an event on the first Sunday of each month from May through
23 October, 2009, on West Street based on the following:

- 24 ■ Time of arts related activities: noon to 5 p.m.
- 25 ■ Amplified entertainment from: noon to 5 p.m. (no testing outside these
- 26 hours is permitted)
- 27 ■ Festival is open to the public free of charge
- 28 ■ Setup and breakdown time: 8:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on the first Sunday
- 29 of each month
- 30 ■ Location: West Street between Church Circle and Cathedral & Calvert
- 31 Streets ~~and West Washington Street~~
- 32 ■ Street closing: West Street between Church Circle and Calvert Street
- 33 ~~and West Washington Street~~ during First Sunday events on May 3, June
- 34 7, July 5, August 2, September 6, and October 4, 2009.
- 35 ■ Stage for First Sundays is to be located in the Stan and Joe’s Saloon
- 36 parking lot at 37 West Street for entertainment that consists of music,
- 37 folklore, and literary readings. Additional stage may be located in the

1 Whitmore Park on Calvert Street with permission of Anne Arundel
2 county.

- 3 ■ The West Street Business Association, or its designee, is required to
4 obtain all city permits for Special Events Application for Private Use of
5 Public Space, temporary structures, electrical connections and pre/post
6 event inspections determined necessary for the safe execution of the
7 event when those elements are required for the execution of the day's
8 activities
- 9 ■ Vendors selling arts and crafts will be sited in cooperation with the
10 Annapolis Police Department; each vendor must post applicable
11 business licenses.

13 **WHEREAS,** Section 7.40.090 of the City Code allows the City Council to designate
14 certain days when peddlers, hawkers and itinerant merchants may sell in
15 the Historic District or a nonresidential area without having licenses issued,
16 Section 6.04.210 permits the City Council, by resolution, to waive full fees
17 for City services, and R-36-2000 provides guidelines for waiving full fees.
18

19 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that sales
20 of arts and crafts may be sold on West Street between Church Circle and Calvert/Cathedral
21 Streets ~~and on West Washington Street~~ by those entities associated with the First Sunday
22 events to be held May 3, June 7, July 5, August 2, September 6, and October 4, 2009, and
23 ethnic food and beverages may be sold at the August 2 and September 6 events;

25 **AND, BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
26 **COUNCIL** that the City Council, finding that the waiving of fees for First Sunday for its use
27 of City property and City services is in the best interest of the City and the public, hereby
28 waives for each of the six First Sunday events, approximately \$1025.00 in fees for all
29 parking meters on West Street between Church Circle and Calvert Street, plus fees for
30 fifteen parking meters on Calvert Street.
