10 **March Madness Sidewalk Sale in Downtown Annapolis**

12 **FOR** the purpose of permitting the temporary sale of merchandise and non-alcoholic
13 items in front of participating businesses on specified sidewalks in connection with
14 the March Madness Sidewalk Sale organized by the Annapolis Business Association
15 to be held on March 27, 28, and 29, 2009.

17 **WHEREAS,** it is expected that City staff will soon approve the event application by the
18 Annapolis Business Association; and

20 **WHEREAS,** Section 7.40.090 of the City Code allows the City Council to designate
21 certain days when peddlers, hawkers and itinerant merchants may sell in
22 the Historic District or a nonresidential area without having licenses issued.

24 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that
25 temporary sales of merchandise and non-alcoholic items in front of participating businesses
26 on the following sidewalks in connection with the March Madness Sidewalk Sale organized
27 by the Annapolis Business Association and to be held on March 27, 28, and 29, 2009, is
28 hereby approved:

- 29 ▪ Maryland Avenue between State Circle and King George Street
- 30 ▪ Randal Street between Market Space and Prince George Street
- 31 ▪ the northwest side of Market Space between Main Street and Pinkney Street
- 32 ▪ State Circle
- 33 ▪ Main Street
- 34 ▪ Inner West Street between Church Circle and Cathedral Street

1 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL**
2 that the placement of any temporary sales racks or display tables shall permit the passage
3 of pedestrians on the public sidewalks. Sidewalks will not be closed to pedestrian traffic.
