11 **Waiving Fees for Maryland Avenue Festivals**

12
13 **FOR** the purpose of waiving fees for City services to be provided in connection with the
14 Maryland Avenue Spring Fling on April 26, 2009, the Maryland Avenue Irish Festival
15 on June 21, 2009, the Maryland Avenue Annual Street Festival on September 20,
16 2009, and the Halloween Festival on October 25, 2009.

18 **WHEREAS,** City Code Section 6.04.210 provides that whenever a person or
19 organization receives City services in connection with the use or occupation
20 of a City facility, or in connection with a special event, parade or gathering,
21 the person or organization shall be charged full fees for the services, but
22 that those fees may be waived by resolution of the City Council pursuant to
23 guidelines adopted by the City Council; and

25 **WHEREAS,** it is expected that City staff will soon approve the event applications by the
26 Maryland Avenue and State Circle Associations for all four events; and

27
28 **WHEREAS,** the Annapolis City Police Department has calculated the cost to the City for
29 each event to be \$650.00 (for 26 meters at \$25 each); and

31 **WHEREAS,** Section 7.40.090 of the City Code allows the City Council to designate
32 certain days when peddlers, hawkers and itinerant merchants may sell in
33 the Historic District or a nonresidential area without having licenses issued,
34 and Section 6.04.210 permits the City Council, by resolution, to waive full
35 fees for City services.

1 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that sales
2 of food and alcoholic beverages from Galway Bay, pending approval of a separate alcoholic
3 beverage control license, plus sales of arts, crafts, antiques, specialty clothing, and food
4 from other vendors, may be sold at the Maryland Avenue Spring Fling on April 26, 2009,
5 the Maryland Avenue Irish Festival on June 21, 2009, the Maryland Avenue Annual Street
6 Festival on September 20, 2009, and the Halloween Festival on October 25, 2009, by those
7 entities associated with the four festivals. However, there shall be no sales, exhibits, or
8 entertainment on Maryland Avenue from Cumberland Court to King George Street.

10 **AND, BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
11 **COUNCIL** that the City Council, finding that the waiving of fees for use of City property and
12 City services is in the best interest of the City and the public, hereby waives fees, not to
13 exceed \$650 for each event, for parking meter fees for parking meters located on Maryland
14 Avenue.
