11 **FOR** the purpose of requesting the Board of Supervisors of Elections and the  
12 Maryland State's Attorney's Office Anne Arundel County's State's  
13 Attorney's Office to investigate a racist and homophobic flier distributed  
14 during the 2009 City of Annapolis General Election.

15  
16 **WHEREAS**, shortly before the November 3, 2009, General Election a flier  
17 bearing racist and homophobic content was distributed throughout  
18 the City; and

19  
20 **WHEREAS**, the City of Annapolis is committed to the equality of its citizens,  
21 regardless of race, gender, or sexual orientation; and

22  
23 **WHEREAS**, although repudiated by all candidates named in the flier, the flier's  
24 content and distribution may constitute a violation of City and State  
25 law.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL**  
28 that the City Council requests the City of Annapolis Board of Supervisors of  
29 Elections and the Maryland State's Attorney's Office Anne Arundel County's  
30 State's Attorney's Office immediately investigate the flier and the circumstances  
31 surrounding its distribution.
