

City of Annapolis Giving Away 200 Trees

Where: Truxtun Park Pool on Primrose Road

When: Saturday, October 24, 2008 from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

- One tree per household, one resident can only pick up trees for four other residents.
- All residents must show a valid driver's license with a City of Annapolis address (if a resident is not present, a copy of the person's driver's license needs to be shown); all trees must be planted within the City of Annapolis limits (a [waiver](#) must be signed by each resident).
- The City will not deliver the trees; City residents must have a vehicle that can fit a 5-7 gallon tree (approximately 6 feet tall).
- First come, first served on species selection. The City will not accept reservations for the trees.
- For matching tree species to site conditions and for proper planting techniques go to chapter four of The [Urban Tree Risk Management Manual](#).

| Chionanthus virginicus/White Fringetree | 33 |
| Cornus kousa/ kousa Dogwood | 33 |
| Ilex opaca/American Holly | 33 |
| Platanus occidentalis/Sycamore | 34 |
| Quercus alba/ White Oak | 33 |
